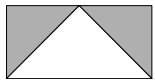
Martha Washington's Star is a four-patch block.

Instructions for a twelve inch block.

Follow separate cutting instructions or use templates.



### Quick pieced units.



From star fabric and background make 4 Flying Geese units to finish at 6 x 3 inches using  $7\frac{1}{4}$  inch and  $3\frac{7}{8}$  inch squares to make four Flying Geese at a time.

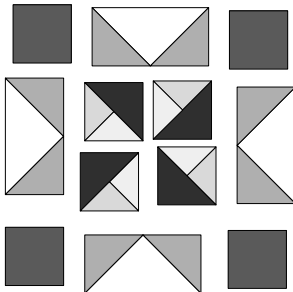


From dark, medium and light fabrics make four 3-triangles units to finish at 3 inches using dark squares  $3\frac{7}{8}$  inches, medium and light squares  $4\frac{1}{4}$  inches.



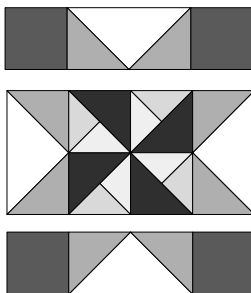
Use the 4,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares for the corners.

### Block



Lay the units out as shown

Stitch the centre units together.



Stitch the units into rows.

Finally stitch the rows together to complete the block.
